Curbside or Collection & Recycling Centers

CLEAN AND EMPTY! (NO LEFTOVERS IN RECYCLING PLEASE...)

DO NOT INCLUDE ANY TRASH; DO NOT BAG THESE ITEMS

- CANS
- CARDBOARD
- CARTONS
- GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS
- PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JUGS
- PAPER



PLEASE BRING THESE ITEMS TO

Collection and Recycling Centers

- COOKING OIL
- COOKIE TINS & STRING LIGHTS (scrap metal)
- PLASTIC BAGS & FILM (separate container)
- TREES: Can be disposed of at select locations: see app
 - LIVE TREES: Must have all lights, decor, tinsel removed can be placed in clean wood containers at select centers.
 - PLASTIC, FLOCKED & DECORATED TREES: Yard trash.
 - METAL TREES: If mostly metal, place in scrap metal

natural trees can be composted!

If you would like to ensure your tree and natural wood items are composted, take them to any of the 6 Lexington County Collection and Recycling Centers that accept CLEAN WOOD listed below. (*Note- not all centers accept clean wood waste)

Please do the following :

- Remove all decor (Including all: Tinsel, Ornaments & Lights)
- Break down wood pieces so they are not greater than 4' in Length or 4" in diameter. *(If unable to get to this size, please bring to Edmund Landfill Composting Facility.)*
- Bring to any of these locations:

1. Ball Park Rd- 301 Ball Park Road Lexington
2. Bush River Rd- 6109 Bush River Rd, Columbia
3. Chapin- 103 Distant Lane, Chapin
4. Edmund Collection Center- 325 Landfill Lane, Lexington
5. Edmund Landfill- 498 Landfill Lane, Lexington
6. Sandhills- 3241 Charleston HWY, Cayce



NOTE: If you participate in Lexington County's Curbside Collection Program, this item is accepted at the curb for YARD WASTE collection. (Please Note: If you leave it curbside it will NOT be composted)

Keep this material separated from garbage and recycled items.
